AMRE PRESIDENTIAL TOUR TO EGYPT - 17 - 23 OCTOBER 2022

The planned itinerary attached (*may be subject to unforeseen change*) include technical visits to mining exploration, oil & gas facilities, portable water plant and rail construction.
