RULES AND INTENT OF THE AMRE STUDY GRANT SCHEME

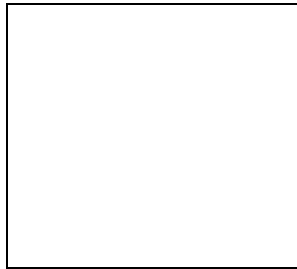
The Association of Mine Resident Engineers (AMRE) is continuously striving towards the development of engineers in the hard rock mining industry. Several fund-raising activities are performed every year to make funds available to a study grant recipient for study at one of the recognised engineering tertiary faculties in South Africa.

The rules and intent of the bursary are listed below:

1. The applicant must study mechanical or electrical engineering at one of the recognised engineering tertiary institutions in South Africa to pursue a career in the hard rock mines.
2. Applications for degree and diploma studies will be considered.
3. Preference will be given to a direct family member of a paid-up member of the AMRE. Direct family means son, stepson, daughter, stepdaughter, brother, sister, or grandchild. If no suitable candidate can be selected from the above group, the study grant committee will evaluate and select a suitable candidate/s from the remainder of the applications.
4. The study grant will contribute to class fees, book fees and residence fees as invoiced by the institution as well as any other study related fees on presentation of invoice and agreed by the AMRE bursary committee up to a maximum of R85 000. Re-imburement, where applicable, will only be done on submitted invoice and proof of payment.
5. The AMRE intend to award a minimum of two such study grants for 2024.
6. Any failed subjects or repeats during study will be for the student's own account.
7. All applications must reach the study grant committee by not later than 30 April 2024. Applications must be scanned and sent to the AMRE secretary Elaine Govender at email address palesat@mpas.org.za clearly marked "AMRE STUDY GRANT APPLICATION 2024" in the subject line.
8. Shortlisted applicants will be called for a personal/online interview during May 2024. The successful study grant recipient will be notified not later than end of May 2024.
9. The successful study grant recipients will be awarded for a one-year period only. On completion of the first year, the student's performance will be evaluated and the study grant may be awarded for the next period. This process will be repeated until the student has finalised the four-year course or the agreement is terminated due to underperformance.
10. The intent of the study grant will be to prepare an engineer for the hard rock mining industry. The AMRE will endeavour to assist the candidate with vacation training and exposure but cannot guarantee placement or remuneration during such period.
11. Any ill-conduct or actions performed by the student which could harm the reputation of the AMRE, or the engineering profession will result in immediate termination of the agreement. The student will have 21 days to appeal in writing to the AMRE council after which the decision will be final.
